## "Charity (Mercy) begins at Home"

The above well-used proverb expresses the overriding need to take care of one's own before caring for others. This school of thought does not seek to denigrate the requirement to support our International brothers and sisters in efforts to alleviate poverty and to respond to those crisis situations that are a constant in newspaper headlines. Nevertheless, we should not forget those vulnerable within our midst – those less newsworthy.

Sadly, the New Forest still sits at the top of Hampshire County Council's league of 'Deprivation'. We still have more than our share of lonely housebound and those, for one reason or another, that have fallen through the cracks of our society.

The St Vincent de Paul Society is a Christian, voluntary organisation dedicated to tackling local poverty of mind and body – irrespective of ideology, faith, ethnicity, age or gender. The first steps in creating the SVP were taken by Antoine Frederic Ozanam. Born in April, 1813 Frederic held the first ever SVP Conference in Paris in April, 1833. Some 184-years later, the Society is still dedicated to doing our best to love our neighbours in a practical way - we pride ourselves in our efforts "to rollup our sleeves and be the artisans of good work".
