This week we also remember two of the 40 Martyrs of England and Wales.

St John Wall, born in Lancashire, 1620. The son of wealthy and staunch Lancashire Catholics, he was sent when very young to <u>Douai College</u>. was made priest, 3 December, 1645, and sent to the Mission 1656, when he returned to the Mission, and for twenty years laboured zealously in Worcestershire. He was apprehended, December, 1678, at Rushock Court near Bromsgrove, & was hung, drawn & quartered 22 August 1679.

John Kemble born 1599 and died a martyr and hanged, drawn and quartered as part of the Titus Oates plot in 1679. He was canonised in 1970. One of Kemble's hands is still preserved at St Francis Xavier Church in Hereford and his body is in St Mary's graveyard Welsh newton.
