Oberammergau pilgrimage - two single rooms available. We have, unexpectedly, a further two single rooms available on our fantastic pilgrimage to Oberammergau and Lake Garda in May 2020. Oberammergau, a village in Germany's Bavarian Alps, is known for its once-a-decade performance of the Passion Play, and those who go to it find it an unforgettable experience. We will spend two nights in Oberammergau followed by three nights in wonderful Lake Garda. We leave by air for Munich on Monday, May 25 and return on Saturday, May 30, 2020.
