This Sunday we reach the end of Eastertide with the great solemnity of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church. Although we return to *tempus per annum* ("ordinary time") next Monday, it will be July before we get another "green" Sunday, with the solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity, Corpus Christi and Saints Peter and Paul filling the remaining Sundays in June. At Pentecost we focus particularly on the Coming of the Holy Spirit, the Advocate whom Jesus promised to send when he ascended to return to His Father.

Pilgrimage through southern Italy to San Giovanni Rotondo

Father Des Connolly SMM will be leading a pilgrimage to Southern Italy from Monday 30th September - Saturday 5th October 2019. The pilgrimage group will visit Padre Pio's birthplace, celebrating Holy Mass in the Parish Church, then a day on the Isle of Capri, celebrating Mass in ancient Church of the Holy Cross. En route to the beautiful shrine of San Giovanni Rotondo (the resting place of Padre Pio) Mass will be celebrated in the Church of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary, a place of miraculous healing, Pompeii. The group will visit the Cathedral shrine of Saint Andrew the Apostle on the Amalfi coast and then spend a few days in San Giovanni Rotondo, including a visit to the shrine of the Archangel Michael. Morning and Evening Prayer of the Church and the Holy Rosary will be prayed together each day with plenty of time for personal prayer.

Ground Package Price is £595 per person based on 2 people sharing and includes the services of an English-speaking courier for the duration of the pilgrimage and in San Giovanni a half day guided tour with a local guide. Flight price is extra from London Gatwick with EasyJet (the sooner you book the cheaper the flight). Supplementary charges: Single Room £100 per person and Travel Insurance £33 per person.
