THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS A DECISION AWAY

CONTEXT: We have lots of superficial acquaintances and connections. They are on the periphery of our lives. There is a general shared benevolence but not necessarily much sharing of values, priorities, principles and concerns. Jesus's contemporaries knew of him, maybe heard him speak. But unlike the apostles and disciples there was no life-changing relationship. Jesus was inviting them (and now invites us!) to move into a new relationship with God and others and the whole of creation characterised by love, forgiveness, compassion, justice, joy, equality, mutual care. The Kingdom is a growing reality of shared life that can be realised by a daily decision, a commitment that has to be renewed each day.

PRAYER: Do we want to enjoy the peace of the Kingdom? Can we disengage from the "ways of the world" - our self-centred habits of thinking, speaking and acting? Growth into joy and freedom and love is possible if we allow God to work in our lives. "How much more will your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

ACTION: If we are to really experience God's Kingdom as a growing, here and now reality, then we have to get beyond mere aspiration. By God's gracious love we have to re-shape our thinking, our speaking and our actions according to the example of Christ. Daily decisions to listen patiently, to speak encouragingly and to act compassionately make the Kingdom a NOW experience and reality (DMA)
