How Do I Find or Gain Favour With God?

Many people today firmly hold that God has a class of people he favours and they are not included in this god's favourites. Our first reading from the book of Ecclesiasticus tells us that we should be humble in carrying out our businesses so as to find favour with the Lord.

All our lives, you and I have sought the FAVOUR of someone. Remember when we were little kids, how we would colour or draw a picture and take it to our mom or dad for their approval? We were seeking their favour. Did you ever have a favourite teacher in grade school or High School? Remember how much harder we worked in that teacher's class? It was because we wanted to find favour in their eyes. And who among us here today didn't do some pretty stupid stuff when we were teenagers......to try to impress our friends or some boy or girl we really liked? It was because we wanted to FIND FAVOUR in their eyes.

"But Noah found favour in the eyes of the Lord."

Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked with God. Now contrast the life of Noah with the way the rest of the world was living at that time. "The Lord saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time. The Lord was grieved that he had made man on earth, and his heart was filled with pain. So the Lord said, "I will wipe mankind, whom I have created, from the face of the earth---men and animals, and creatures that move along the ground, and birds of the air---for I am grieved that I have made them. But Noah found favour in the eyes of the Lord." (Genesis 6:5-8)

How Can You and I Find Favour in the Eyes of the Lord?

As we look a little more closely at NOAH'S life, we find THREE things he did that GOD found favourable.

- 1. Noah Did What Was Right When Everyone Else Was Doing Wrong. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time. 1. We have already learned that NOAH lived in a society where no one did what was right in the eyes of GOD......everyone's mind was bent on doing wrong all the time.
- 2. While everyone around him was chose to do what was right in their own eyes, NOAH choose to do what was right in GOD'S eyes.
- 3. In his book, The Cheating Culture, Don Callahan says, we are living in a time when everybody seems to think it's OK to do wrong, just because everybody else is doing it. School Students cheat on tests, because "everybody's doing it." Athletes take steroids, because "everybody else is doing it." People cheat on insurance claims and tax returns, because "everybody else is doing it."

"Doctors write unnecessary prescriptions, because "everybody else is doing it." "People illegally download music and movies, because "everybody else is doing it." Even many who claim to be Christians reject God's standard of righteousness in favour of what "feels right" for them personally or what society accepts as right.

- 4. In the Eyes of GOD......RIGHT is always RIGHT and WRONG is always WRONG......No matter how many people are doing it. It doesn't matter if all many countries pass laws to legalize every type of perverse behaviour known to man, from same-sex marriages to abortion to child pornography etc. etc.; it will never make it right.
- 5. If you and I are to find favour in the eyes of the lord we must do as Noah did in his day and that is DO RIGHT EVEN WHEN THE WHOLE WORLD IS DOING WRONG. Secondly Noah walked with God Even when no one else did. He was a righteous man, blameless along the people of his time, and he walked with God.
- 6. Spiritually speaking, when we Walk with God we "follow God's footsteps. We stay in step with God, we follow in His path." In Nosh's day no one was walking with GOD, everyone made his own path. Only Noah walked with God Only Noah stayed in step with God, Only Noah followed God's footsteps.

Noah Found Favour in the Eyes of the Lord by Doing What Was Right When Everyone Was Doing Wrong. He Found Favour in the Eyes of the Lord by Walking With God Even When No One Else Did.

Noah Trusted God, Even When He Didn't Understand

- 1. God reveals to Noah his plan to destroy the world. God told Noah he was going to do this by bringing a flood upon the earth. Noah had never seen or heard of a flood before. God gave Noah specific instructions for building this huge boat, which was as long as three football fields and as high as a three-story building. He had never heard of an ARK before. God told Noah he wanted him to take two of every kind of animal on board this big boat, along with the seven members of his family. Noah didn't understand just how he was supposed to get these animals on the Ark. as a matter of fact, he did not understand any of God's plan, but did everything just as God commanded him.
- 2. In your life and mine, there are times when everything inside of us is crying out. "God, this doesn't make a bit of sense!" God is telling us NO....when everything inside us is saying YES.
- -GOD is telling us to WAIT......when everything inside us is telling us to GO AHEAD.
- -GOD is telling us to LEAVE IT ALONE......when everything inside us is telling us to TAKE IT.
- -GOD is telling us NOW IS NOT THE TIME.....when everything inside us is telling us NOW IS THE BEST TIME.
- 3. There will always be times when we do not understand God's plan or His timing, or His Ways. But God does not ask us to *understand*, He asks us to *TRUST HIM and OBEY HIM*. Day after Day for many years, Noah worked on that ark perhaps without ever fully understanding what was to come, and yet he trusted GOD and obeyed him, by doing everything GOD commanded him to do. And Noah Found Favour in the Eyes of the Lord.

CONCLUSION: This account of Noah's life has more to do with you and me than we might think. Do what is RIGHT even if everybody around you is doing wrong! WALK with GOD, even if it seems no one around is. TRUST in GOD, even when YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND. Like Noah, may it be our aim in life to FIND FAVOR IN THE EYES OF THE LORD!
