Kevin is in the 3rd year at the Beda College, Rome. He writes: From 1987-1991 I shared in the community life of L'Arche, monasticism and the Missionaries of Charity, three communities which were to have a big influence on my life and spirituality over the years. I then came to Rome in 1991 to discern my vocation with another community. While in Rome I prayed a novena for the discernment of my vocation. Many years later and here I am still preparing for the priesthood, in Rome, only ten minutes away from the chapel where thirty years ago a Jesuit priest told me to become a diocesan priest. I have no regrets about the 'delay'. Life is a journey. Any vocation for me is first and foremost rooted in our humanity and in the common priesthood of our baptism. I am entering the diocesan priesthood at an interesting time with many challenges ahead for the Church. I think God formed me in His own way during these years and all that I learnt along the way will be of use in fulfilling 'the work to which God has committed me', to use a St. John Henry Newman expression.
