Many of us long for our friends and family to have faith but we don't know how to start a conversation and often there is a culture of silence around talking about God. Yet everyone is searching for meaning and purpose to their lives. How can we listen, understand and accompany our families and friends according to where they are? There is some new training available in the diocese, which shows how to encourage others, affirming them gently and showing them the next step in a possible spiritual journey. It is called Ananias training and is named after the disciple who played an important role in accompanying St. Paul.
