This Sunday 25th June, is the Twelfth Sunday of the Year: Commentary by Fr John Lee Introduction: In his Gospel Matthew sets out to connect Jesus with all the messianic prophecies. Without question Matthew points to Jesus as the Messiah. There is no other. The Christian life is essentially this: Confessing Jesus as the Messiah, living towards the eschaton – the promise of eternal life - with a concern for mission in this world (justice, peace, and the integrity of creation) and letting go of both material possessions AND fear of what others might think about us or do to us. Discipleship is not for the faint-hearted! Some questions the Gospel – ALL the readings - poses for us today: Where is my heart? Can we / I truly say that loyalty to God in Christ comes first? Do I really trust in God and God's future?
